PAY BACK POLICY FOR CATTARAUGUS COUNTY 4-H SPONSORED SHOWS

In order to reduce cash at the show, we will issue checks for paybacks within a few weeks of the show. **You must submit a written complete pre-entry to reserve a stall. PRE-ENTRY MONEY WILL BE REQUIRED FOR STALLS AND CAMPING. NO RESERVATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED BY TELEPHONE.** We will credit paybacks as usual. At the end of your classes, come to the booth to settle your account. We will tally your paybacks and apply them to your expenses. You may settle your bill with cash or a check. If you succeeded in earning a profit, you will receive your check in the mail

No Bedding Will be Supplied! Bring your own bedding.

All pre-entries must be postmarked 10 days prior to the day of the show. Pre-entries must include completed entry form, pre-entry stall and camping fee, Coggins and Rabies certificates. We are requiring stall and camping fees with the pre-entries. There will be a \$10.00 post entry fee the day of the show per exhibitor.(Refund of stalls and camping fee will only be issued with a Vet certificate. No Faxed Entry Forms Will Be Accepted!!)

HORSE ADMITTANCE RESTRICTIONS

All horses admitted on the grounds for the Horse Show must show proof of **Negative E.I.A. COGGINS** dated 2008 or 2009 and Rabies certificate. (Rabies is good for only one year after date of certificate. Rabies is not effective until 14 days after vaccination if lapsed). Proof of Coggins and Rabies will be required to be submitted at each show. We will not be keeping a record throughout the show season.

We strongly suggest that your horses be inoculated for RHINO and have been administered the 4 in 1 Vaccine. (EEE, WEE, TETANUS, FLU)

STALLS STABLING

No Bedding will be provided! Bring your own bedding.

Box stalls & tack stalls will be provided on a first come first serve basis with a **complete pre-entry form and pre-entry fees. Phone reservations will not be taken.** There will be a \$60 charge for each stall for the entire weekend. Twenty dollars will be refunded if the stall is stripped and inspected prior to leaving the grounds. This fee will be assessed regardless of the number of days you intend to stay. However, it is critical that you let us know the dates and times of your arrival and departure as stalls will be used to capacity. We plan to use every available stall for housing horses. If you wish to be stabled next to friends or family members - please give names. Every attempt will be made to accommodate your request, however there is no guarantee. If your stall is not clean, when you arrive, please immediately report this information to the entry booth ASAP. All horses staying overnight must be stalled in the barn. Do not make stall changes on your initiative. All stalls are assigned by Horse Show staff.

All overnight horses must be stalled. No horses may be tied to trailers, fences, or buildings overnight.

ARRIVAL TIME: **Stalls will not be labeled prior to 2 P.M. Friday.** Please give us ample time to make assignments. Call the show manager if you can not abide with this time frame

The **HORSE SHOW** will be governed by the rules of the USEF, 4-H Rules, & AQHA.

PRE-ENTRIES

1. Complete enclosed pre-entry form including classes.
2. **Include copies of coggins and rabies.** Re-submit coggins and rabies for each show.
3. **Pre-entry forms must be post marked ten days prior to show day.**
4. **No stalls will be reserved without a complete pre-entry sheet (including stall fees, camping fees),** Please include your classes so we can do the paperwork ahead
Fill in all the necessary information, your signature is mandatory
If Pre-entry payment includes fees for camping and stall for more than one exhibitor, please provide explanation to ensure appropriate payment distribution
5. **SEND ALL PRE-ENTRY FORMS AND PRE-ENTRY FEES TO:** Cornell Cooperative Extension, 28 Parkside Drive, Ellicottville, N.Y. 14731-9707.

The show committee assigns exhibitor numbers prior to the show. When filling out your class numbers, please note the following:

- * Numbers will be assigned on a horse/rider combination basis.
- * Exhibitors riding two or more equines must have a **separate number** and entry form for each animal.
- * TWO RIDERS (Exhibitors) riding the same horse will be assigned two separate numbers and must ride in different divisions.
- * Use a separate entry form for exhibitors who ride different horses.
- * **Pre-enter all classes to avoid a \$1.00 per class add & scratch fee..**
- **Post entry fee will be \$10.00 per exhibitor.**
Points will be tabulated on the same horse/rider team/division
- Shows will start at 8:00 a.m. each day
- All exhibitors must sign the insurance liability waiver before receiving their exhibitor number. It is the parents responsibility to sign the youth insurance liability wavier (18 and under), not the trainers

ALL PRE-ENTRY INFORMATION MUST BE LEGIBLE, CORRECT, AND COMPLETE.

Attention - Jr. Horse Exhibitors - proof of equine age should accompany entries (i.e. breeders certificate, registration papers, etc).

Adds and scratches must be submitted in writing three classes ahead. A \$1.00 fee will be charged for each class added or scratched. No adds or scratches will be accepted after 1:00 p.m. of each day for performance classes.

ALL CLASSES WILL BE RUN AS SCHEDULED - RAIN OR SHINE

APPROVED HELMETS ARE MANDATORY FOR ALL RIDERS DUE TO OUR INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

FAIRGROUNDS RULES

All dogs must be leashed and under control. NO bicycles or motorized bikes or carts. Parents are responsible for the safety and actions of their children.

No one under the age of 18 can stay on the grounds unless accompanied by a responsible adult.

Please respect the facilities and use them properly, this **includes the rest room.**
No alcoholic beverages at the show ring, show office and in the barns

CAMPERS TENTS BOOTHS

You are welcome to bring your own campers or tents. There will be **No Campers or Tents Set Up In The Pole Barn Area.** **Sites will be assigned.** **Please park to the fence.** **Camper spots are not for horse trailer storage.** **Horse Trailers may be parked near the main gate.** With your cooperation, we can manage our grounds to provide adequate schooling area.

Camping - Camping sites are assigned. Limited hook-ups in designated locations are available and are assigned on a first come basis. If wheeled camper and tents occupy the same site, they must be contained in the site. Camper signs will be provided at the office and must be prominently displayed. **All overnight stays are considered camping.** Horse trailers used for sleeping quarters must pay for camping. Camper Fees are \$20.00/per day. Camping must be pre-paid. Be courteous to others, please do not block other campers with your vehicles.

Commercial displays or booths may set up for a fee of \$35.00/day with electric hookups and \$25.00/day without electric.

Concession's will open Friday evening and daily until Sunday evening. They will be serving breakfast as well as fast foods and specials for lunch and dinner.

DIRECTIONS TO THE FAIRGROUNDS

From Salamanca, take Route 353 north from the west end of Route 417 to Little Valley. From Ellicottville take Route 242 to Little Valley (beware of a very steep hill). In Little Valley go straight through the light, the fairgrounds is on your right about a mile ahead. Enter at the main gate.

Year end awards will be given to the high point horse and rider combination from Bonanza and Fall Classic Performance shows. All three shows will count for gymkhana riders (Bonanza, Schooling, & Fall Classic). Exhibitors must have participated in both shows to be eligible for year end performance awards and must show in at least two out of three shows for year end gymkhana divisions. Divisions may be canceled, combined, or altered by the 4-H Horse Committee.

AGES CLASSES DIVISIONS

- JUNIOR** 17 years and under as of Jan.1st
- SENIOR** 18 years and over as of Jan. 1st
- PONY** **All ponies must be 14.2 and under.** Ponies may be ridden both English & Western. Ponies may also enter in divisions designated by the exhibitor's age group. Ponies must be measured before the first pony class.
Ponies may not be ridden in Walk Trot & Pony with the same rider.
- GAMES** Games will be divided into Walk Trot (No age restriction), Novice, Jr. (8 -18), and Sr. (19 and over) -- Games will begin on Friday at 7:00 p.m. with divided classes and Open Classes. Games will continue on Saturday at 7:00 p.m. (following the completion of the performance classes.) A 15 second penalty will be added if the can stays on the barrel in Pop the Can AND the ring does not stay on the pole in the Ring A Poles Classes.. Jr./Sr. & Open games will receive paybacks-but no ribbons with the \$6.00 ribbon cost added to premiums. Proper riding attire is required. (Long Sleeved Shirt, and Heeled Boots). All three Games Shows will count toward year end points. You must participate in at least two shows to be eligible for year end awards.
- WALK/TROT** **Restricted division** - exhibitors may enter only Walk Trot Performance and/or WT Games classes. Open to English and Western Exhibitors. Due to the large number of entries in the past, classes will be divided **8 to 14 English, 8 to 14 Western , 15 & up.** Exhibitors must be able to control their equine independently and safely. *Walk/Trot year end champion and reserve champion must move up to Novice or their age group.* This is a restricted division, riders may not enter any other division.
- NOVICE** **Restricted division** - designed for exhibitors who are beginner riders and not able to compete in other performance divisions - gaits in classes are called at the judge's discretion. Walk, trot or jog, and **lope or canter will be required.** (The lope/canter **may** be called individually at the judges discretion.) (Exhibitors may not cross enter into any other performance division, however, may ride in the novice games division.) *Novice year end champion and reserve champion must move up to their age group.*
- OPEN** Any exhibitor may enter in Open Classes.(Except exhibitors in restricted divisions, Walk-Trot & Novice.) Placings and points in Open classes will not count on other division
- TRAIL** All trail classes will be held in a separate ring (area) on Saturday and will be judged by the **Trail Class Judge between the hours of 11:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.** All exhibitors must complete the trail course between these times.
- JR. HORSE** Limited to horses 5 & under as of January 1st. Must use same equipment (bit, bosal) for all other open classes. If the equipment is changed the horse will be disqualified from the Jr. Horse division and entries forfeited.

Miniature Horses may be led or driven, must be under 38" in height, can not enter driving classes # 100 & 101

Classes May Be Canceled, Combined or Divided At The Discretion Of The Horse Show Committee. In Classes With 4 Or Fewer Entries There Will Be Ribbons But No Paybacks.
