Use pink achievement forms to record your points. Return to the 4-H office by the 10<sup>th</sup> of the following month with your secretaries minutes.

.	<b><u>Item</u></b>	<b><u>Points</u></b>	<b><u>Description</u></b>
1.	New Club Enrollment or Re-enrollment	<b>100</b>	All new members enrolled by April 1 All re-enrollments in 4-H office by Dec. 1 <sup>st</sup>
2.	Club Program Plan	<b>50</b>	If sent to 4-H office by December 1
3.	New members for club	<b>25</b> <b>10</b>	For each new member by December 1 For each new member by April 1
4.	Secretary's Book Submitted	<b>50</b>	Complete Secretary's book submitted 4-H office by the September deadline
5.	Attendance at Club Meetings	<b>20</b> <b>15</b>	For 100% attendance For 50% attendance
6.	Attendance at County-wide	<b>20</b>	Per member that attends (Examples: officer's Training Public Presentation or Produced in New York Workshop)
7.	Leaders Attendance at County-wide Training's	<b>20</b>	Per leader that attends any training's or workshops
8.	Participation in other 4-H Activities or events	<b>25</b> <b>50</b> <b>100</b>	Regional/District level (Animal Science Events, State Level State Clothing Revue National Level
8.	Attend County-wide contests	<b>20</b>	Per member demonstrating (Examples: "Produced in New York, Public Presentations, Clothing Revue, Animal Science activities)
9.	Fair Exhibits	<b>20</b>	Per member exhibiting at County Fair
10.	Community Service	<b>200</b>	At least half the club must participate and return a Community Service Report to the 4-H office.
11.	Sponsoring a New Club	<b>200</b>	Sponsoring a new club by finding leadership and members. The new club must complete the 4-H year.

12.	4-H Club Tour (Dairy Tours, Fabric Shops)	<b>100</b>	Conducted by club; must be educational
13.	Invite other club/ind. to your tour	<b>100</b>	Open tour up to other clubs and individuals in county (must submit article to Newsreel to advertise tour)
14.	Completion of Portfolios	<b>500</b>	If every member completes a portfolio (25 points less for each member who does not complete one)
15.	Special Awards	<b>50</b>	Per member who receives (Junior Tailor, Best of Show, Produced in NY top 10, Evie Karn, Showmanship awards, etc.)

All clubs are encouraged to participate. Winning club will be announced at Recognition Day Banquet. Winning Club will receive pizza party and choice of activity (bowling, miniature golf, roller or ice skating).
